WORLDLOPPET PASSPORTS



All cross-country ski marathon enthusiasts can purchase a <u>Worldloppet Passport</u>. This passport is a personal document, in which every completed Worldloppet race should be registered. The official WL Passport contains a special page for each event in the Worldloppet series. After completing of a WL race, the skier should ask for the official stamp of this event at the race office. A stamp in the WL Passport is the evidence of the completed race.

After completing WL races in 10 different countries, at least one of them on another continent, the skier owning a Worldloppet passport can apply for the **Worldloppet Master** title. The passport does not have an expiry date. It remains valid until you claim your Master title. If you wish to gain another Master title you will need to purchase a new passport.

A further challenge after becoming a Worldloppet Master is to work towards the title of **Global Skier**. This is awarded to skiers who have completed all 17 different Worldloppet full member races.

Passports can be purchased for \$60 in the Hoppet Shop or ordered through the race office at other times. Bring or send a passport photo to be affixed to your new passport.

There are three opportunities to have your passport stamped:

- In the Passport/Information tent at the finish, next to the First Aid tent,
- At the Presentation Party in Mt Beauty from 7pm 9pm, and
- At the Hoppet Shop in Mt Beauty from 9 am on Sunday after the race.

New Australian Worldloppet Masters can be recognised at the Presentation Party Saturday night. Contact the Race Secretary for details.
